NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOMESCHOOL
Pursuant to NRS 392.070

Please complete a separate Notice of Intent form for each child. The form is required for children from age 7 to 18 only. This is a one-time filing and does not need to be refiled unless the name or address of the parent or child changes, or the child is reentering homeschooling after being enrolled in public school.

If the child has reached the age of 7, which is the age that attendance at a public school becomes mandatory per NRS 392.040, a Notice of Intent to Homeschool must be filed before beginning to homeschool the child or:

- a) Not later than 10 days after the child has been formally withdrawn from enrollment in public school; or
- b) Not later than 30 days after establishing residency in Nevada.

If the educational plan contains the requirements of this section, the educational plan must not be used in any manner as a basis for denial of a notice of intent to homeschool that is otherwise complete.

Upon completion, make a copy for your records, and mail or deliver the original to the Superintendent of Schools for the county in which you reside.

The Superintendent must accept a Notice of Intent to Homeschool that is filed with him pursuant to, and meeting the requirements of, NRS 392.070, and shall not require or request any additional information or assurances from the parent who filed the notice. The school district shall provide to a parent who files a notice a written acknowledgment which clearly indicates that the parent has provided notification required by law and that the child is being homeschooled. The written acknowledgment shall be deemed proof of compliance with Nevada's compulsory school attendance law.
